

Genius – Artificial Intelligence!

Genius is Artificial Intelligence modelled on Amazon. When you buy a product from their website and visit the check out, other items are suggested that are frequently bought at the same time as your product.



‘People who bought that, also bought this’

‘Evidence which addresses that, may also address this’

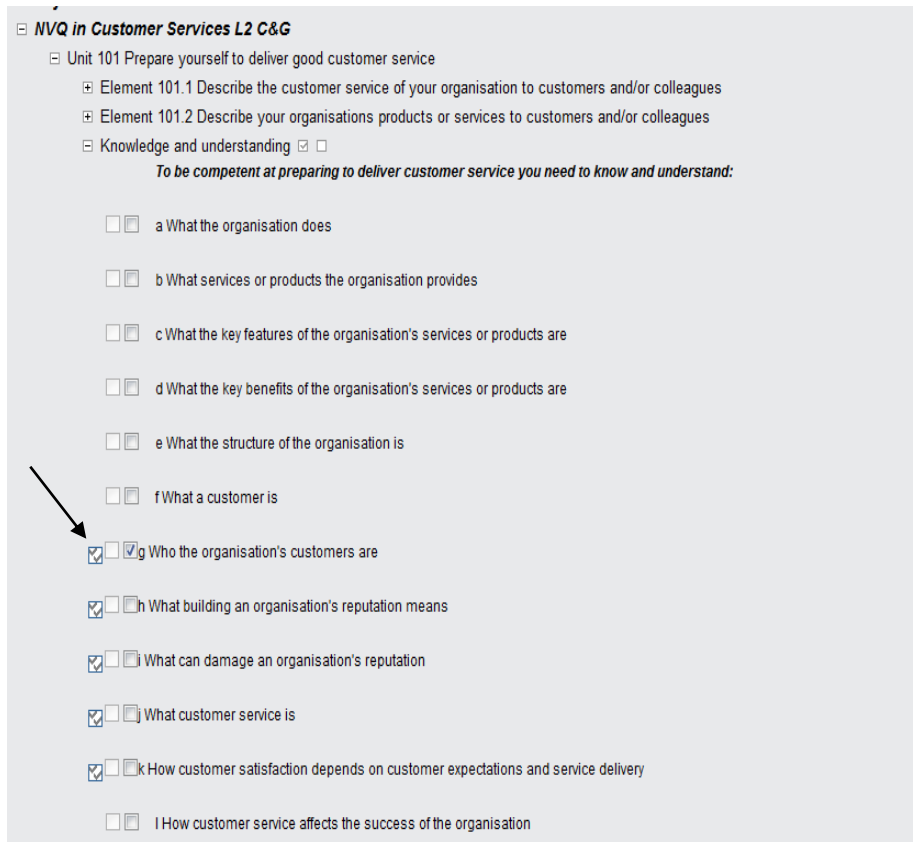
Genius has been created to allow a centre to start to collate data on the assessment habits of their assessors, and start to suggest links between assessment criteria. Thresholds are set to allow for different sized organisations, so that the suggestions presented are relevant, and represent real correlations.

There are two thresholds set. The hard threshold is a number, and prevents too small a sample starting to suggest links. This can be tweaked as more data is accrued, but generally we believe a threshold of **50** links is a good start. The calculated percentage threshold takes over once the hard threshold has been reached. Again this can be tweaked. This is usually set around **30%**.

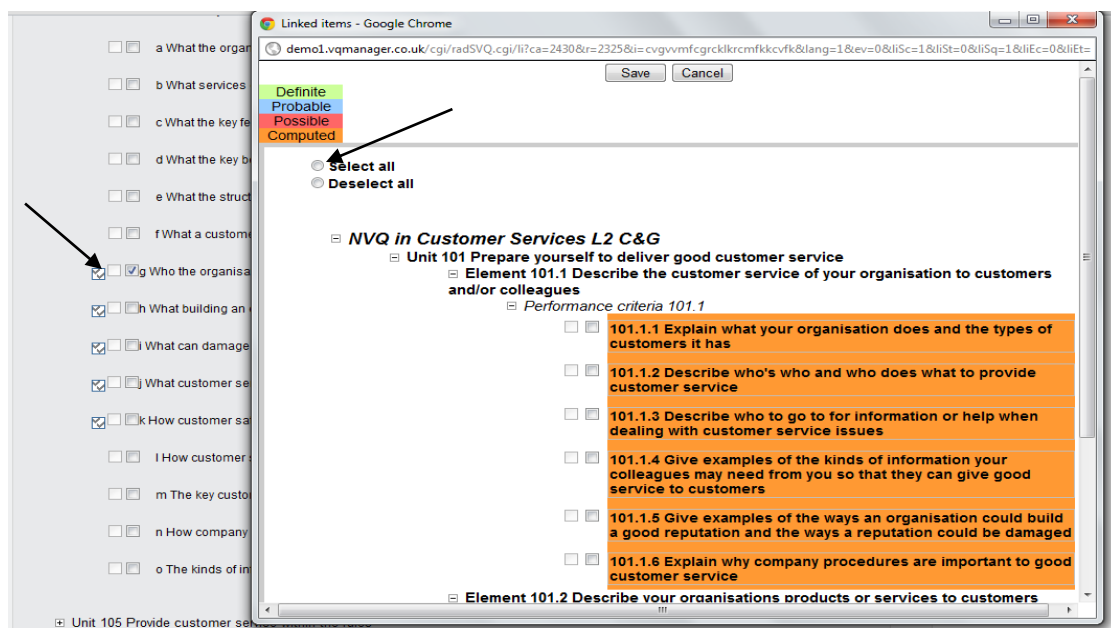
Genius:

- Enables new assessors to assess with the wisdom of more experienced ones so faster and better assessment
- Avoids learner having to repeat activities, so improves retention
- Provides cross-referencing – i.e. the ability to show the assessor that evidence which addresses one particular Assessment Criterion (AC) might well also address another

When an assessor logs a piece of evidence the double tick icon appears next to criteria which have Genius links to view.



The assessor clicks on the icon and a pop up appears showing all the linked criteria. The assessor has total control over what criteria are ticked. The “Select all” button can be used to populate all the linked criteria if required.
